Placemat Pattern

- 1. Decide on the size. Cut two rectangles in the desired mat size plus 0.5 inches (1.3 cm) on all sides to allow for seams. A typical size is 12" x 18".
- **2. Position the fabric for sewing.** Sew the two rectangles with printed or "right" sides facing together, leaving a 3–4 inches (7.6–10.2 cm) open unstitched space for turning.
- **3. Remove corners for turning.** Miter the corners by cutting a wedge off each corner. This helps the placemat lie flat for the next step.
- 4. Pull fabric through the open unstitched space. Turn it "right" side out
- **5. Flatten the seam allowance at the opening.** Slip stitch the opening closed.
- **6. Add finishing stitches.** Top stitch around the perimeter. Use a zig zag stitch with contrasting thread for a decorative touch.
- **7. Congratulations!** You have just sewn a placemat!
