7. Pull the main fabric out of the sewn tube until flat. Press.

Sew4Service Three Fabric Pillowcases


- 1. Place Cuff Fabric right side up (full length)
- Press Trim Fabric in half long ways, right side out, raw edges together. Lay on top of the Cuff Fabric and pin in place.
- 3. Place the Main Fabric right side down on top of the prior two layers, matching raw edges. Pin in place using pins in step 2.
- 4. Roll up the main fabric until the cuff fabric shows.

- 5. Roll the cuff fabric over the main fabric, matching the raw edges. Pin the cuff fabric in place using the pins in step 3. (Do not pin the other end of the main fabric)
- 6. Stitch a quarter inch seam down the entire length. Remove the pins.

Supplies Needed: 27" x 42" Main Fabric 2" x 42" Trim Fabric 11" x 42" Cuff Fabric Pins







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- 8. Fold the sewn fabric in half, **right sides out**, same color fabric on top of each other.
- 9. Sew a 1/8" ¼" seam across the bottom and side of the pillow case.

- 10. Turn the pillow case inside out and flatten the seams.
- 11. Sew another $\frac{1}{2}$ " 5/8" seam, making sure you enclose the raw edge underneath. (French Seam)

12. Turn right side out, and admire your finished

pillow case.
